<p>WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP: *NOTE: PLEASE MARK ALL ITEMS WITH YOUR CAMPER'S NAME*</p>		
<p>Bedding - sleeping bags or sheets & blanket, pillow & case. Each bed is equipped with a foam mattress.</p> <p>Personal Toiletries - bath & beach towel, soap, shampoo, toothpaste, tooth brush, deodorant, brush.</p> <p>Clothes - swim suit (one piece swimsuit preferred), shorts, t-shirts, long pants, socks, running shoes & sandals, hat, raincoat, sweater & jacket for cooler weather.</p> <p>Equipment - insect repellent, sun screen, lip balm, flashlight & extra batteries, camera.</p> <p>Medication - Send medication in original bottles, along with dosage instructions, to camp. Your bottles to be labelled with your name. Your camper application form should list all medications. All medications, prescription or otherwise, must be turned in upon arrival. Failure to do so could result in your dismissal from camp.</p>		
<p>WHAT NOT TO BRING TO CAMP:</p>		
<p>I-Pods, MP3 players, cell phones, knives, matches, food, smoking materials, drugs, alcohol or offensive reading material. Note: Illicit drugs brought to camp will be confiscated and proper authorities notified.</p>
